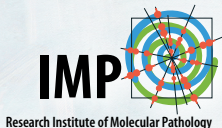


IMP Vienna

Applications are invited for a group leader position at the IMP, Vienna.

The IMP is one of the world's leading basic research institutes in the molecular life sciences. Researchers at the IMP conduct curiosity-driven research across a broad range of topics, including computational biology, structural biology, cell and developmental biology, immunology, and neurobiology. Our common objective is to uncover fundamental molecular and cellular mechanisms underlying complex biological phenomena.

We aim to recruit a group leader with a strong and innovative research programme in any area of the molecular life sciences, particularly in neurobiology, cell biology, and/or mouse genetics.
