

Call for Expressions of Interest

Bioscientist - Kollias lab | BSRC Fleming



The lab of Dr. George Kollias at the Biomedical Sciences Research Center 'Alexander Fleming' (www.fleming.gr) is seeking a **bioscientist** with proven track record in the analysis and characterization of chronic inflammatory diseases (central nervous system, intestinal or joint inflammation) or cancer in animal models of human disease.

Candidates must hold a MSc or PhD in Biological Sciences or related fields and excellent command of the English language. Previous experience in the development and characterisation of animal models of disease is required. Additionally, experience with mouse models of neurodegeneration, chronic inflammation or cancer is desirable, and experience in immunological phenotyping (including bioimaging) will be advantageous. Proven expertise in histology, immunofluorescence and cell culture techniques, and high impact publications are desirable.

The successful applicant will be a member of a highly interactive research group that operates across immunology, molecular biology, systems biology and animal modeling and will be expected to interact closely and productively with scientists from different disciplines. The successful applicant will be involved in studies of neuroinflammation and neurodegeneration in mouse models of disease.
