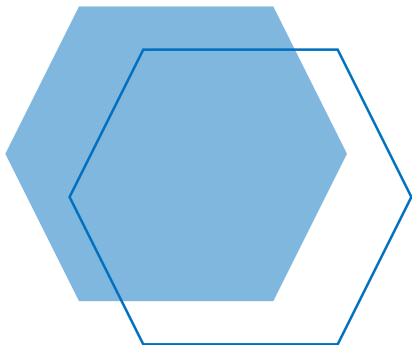

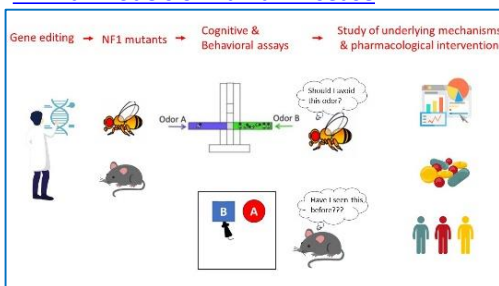
The OpenFleming initiative has enabled our Center to disseminate its activities and introduce the world of biomedical research to the public by enriching our online presence.

We have achieved this through the design and production of a variety of digital informative material, including videos, interactive virtual lab tours, social media posts, science webinars, vidcasts and newsletters.

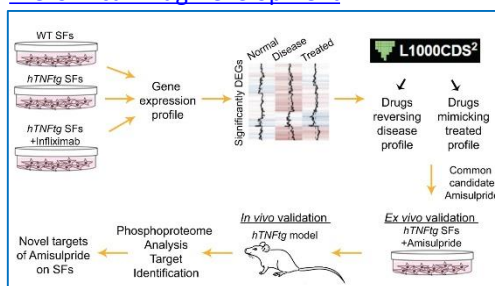

Building construction ends



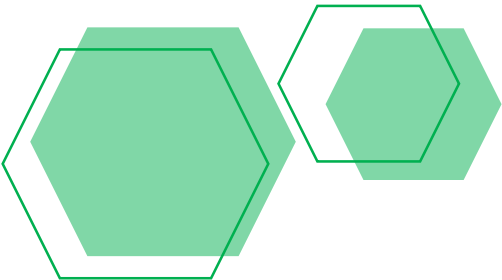
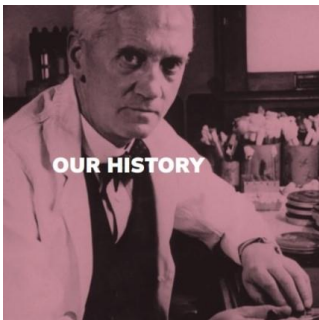
